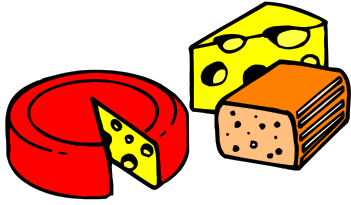

# Appetizers

- ❖ Write your words 5 times each.
- ❖ Write your words in ABC order.
- ❖ Write your words. Circle the vowels and underline the consonants.
  - ❖ Write your words and cross out all of the silent letters.
  - ❖ Write your words neatly in cursive.
  - ❖ Write your words forwards, then backwards.
- ❖ Write your spelling words then add up each spelling word.  
Consonants = 10 points, vowels = 5.  
Ex. CAT:  $10 + 5 + 10 = 25$
- ❖ Write your spelling words; then rewrite them making all vowels lowercase and all consonants uppercase.

# Beverages



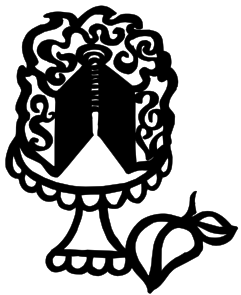
- ❖ Write tongue twisters using your words.
- ❖ Write your word. Write your word again scrambled next to it.
  - ❖ Make a crossword puzzle with your words.
  - ❖ Write a creative story using at least 15 of your words.
    - ❖ Write your words in a code.
  - ❖ Draw a picture and hide your words in your picture.
    - ❖ Write newspaper headlines for your words.
    - ❖ Create a word link with your words.
    - ❖ Make a poem with your words.
    - ❖ Make a pyramid using your words.
- ❖ Write a letter to a friend using all of your spelling words.

# Entrees



- ❖ Write sentences using your words.
- ❖ Write an antonym for each of your words.
  - ❖ Write a synonym for each of your words.
  - ❖ Classify the words according to parts of speech.
    - ❖ Use the words in similes or metaphors.
- ❖ Add prefixes or suffixes to your words and write the new meaning of the word.
  - ❖ Write riddles for 15 of your spelling words.
- ❖ Write your words and then write two words that can be made from each of your words. Example: pasta: past, sat.
- ❖ Write an acrostic poem with each of your words. Example CAT  
Curious Creature  
Attention Seeker  
Tabby Cat

# Desserts



- ❖ Make a set of flashcards for your words.
- ❖ Make spelling tiles or use alphabet pasta, cereal, or magnetic alphabet letters and arrange the letters to form your words. \*\*
  - ❖ Cut the words out of a magazine and paste them on paper.
  - ❖ Read a newspaper, find your spelling words and circle them.
- ❖ Write your words in whipped cream, peanut butter, sugar, or any other safe product you have at home. \*\*
  - ❖ Cheer your words out loud to practice them. \*\*
  - ❖ Use string to form your letters and spell your words. \*\*
- ❖ Make your words using popsicle sticks, toothpicks, or other materials. \*\*
  - ❖ Write your spelling words in pencil, then trace over with 2 different colors.
  - ❖ Write your spelling words once in bubble letters and once in squiggly letters.
    - ❖ Write your words as dots, and then connect the dots.
