**Nominations open Sept. 1 for  
2008 Golden Apple Awards**

(CHICAGO — Aug. 27, 2007) Nominations are open September 1 through December 1 for the 2008 Golden Apple Awards for Excellence in Teaching.

To be eligible for the 23rd annual awards, nominees must be full-time classroom teachers currently teaching in grades 4 through 8 at a public or non-public school located in Cook, DuPage, Kane, Lake and Will counties of Illinois. Nominees also must be committed to continue teaching for at least two years after receiving the award.

Ten award winners will receive a paid sabbatical to study tuition-free at Northwestern University, a laptop computer, \$3,000, induction into the Golden Apple Academy of Educators, and recognition in September on a one-hour WTTW/11 TV special.

Award finalists will be announced in February; the 10 winners will be named in April.
